Requirements for ordinations to the rank of Psaltis - πιψελ της

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Lead the congregation in the chanting of hymns of praises
- Chant in unison with the church chorus

<u>Requirements:</u>

The Coptic Orthodox male members of the parishes of this diocese who are presented for ordination to the ranks of psaltis (chanter) must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. Be at least six years old.
- 2. Display proper Christian behavior including:
 - a. Regular confession, church attendance and communion
 - b. Proper attire and general appearance, such as clothes, hair etc.
 - c. Not be under the sway of bad habits, such as smoking or drinking alcohol
- 3. Demonstrate proficiency in all the congregation hymns of the Divine Liturgy of St. Basil in any language.
- 4. Demonstrate at least 80% attendance rate in the weekly Divine Liturgies.
